Vita Matthew is internationally acknowledged as a passionate advocate for green cities and with regard to his expertise on urban green infrastructure design and implementation. He has a diverse background incorporating disciplines of architecture, landscape design and sustainable building design over a thirty year career, however since 2008 his work has specifically focused on green roof policy development, design and advocacy.

In 2009 Matthew was responsible for writing Australia's first Green Roof Guidelines for the City of Sydney and in 2013-14 formed an Advisory Panel to assist in the development of a Green Roof Policy. The policy was accepted in 2014. He has designed several green roofs and living walls since 2011.

Matthew has presented at congresses in Mexico, France, China, Japan, Australia, Singapore, Columbia & Malaysia on topics including Water Sensitive Urban Design; Mitigation of Climate Change Impacts; Policy Development; Australian Case Studies; Green Infrastructure Transition and Retrofit Project Management.
