Speaker Aslan Janoubi

Vita Aslan Jonoubi was born in 1975 in Shiraz, Iran. Aslan holds a Master of Architecture, from Shiraz Azad University (2001), a Master of Urban Design, from the University of Toronto, Canada (2004), and has been a Professor of Architecture and Urban Design in various Iranian universities since 2005.

He is now teaching at Shiraz Azad University as a full time professor. Aslan's vision of his professional life includes the design and implementation of over 350 projects of architecture, landscape and urban design, as well as writing policy for green roofs for the capital city of Shiraz, Iran.

He has supervised more than 150 green roof projects in Iran, and presented many papers at world conferences around the world about vertical greenery and tall green buildings. Aslan's accomplishments include:
