Speaker Dr. Scott MacIvor

Vita Scott is an Assistant Professor of urban ecology at the University of Toronto at Scarborough in the Department of Biological Sciences. He obtained his PhD in Biology from York University in Toronto, Canada, his MSc in Applied Science from Saint Mary's University in Halifax, Canada, and his BSc. in Ecology from the University of Guelph in Canada.

Scott is also a researcher at the Green Roof Innovation Testing (GRIT) lab at the University of Toronto in the faculty of Landscape Architecture, and has taught urban ecology to science and non-science students at York, Ryerson, and in three departments at the University of Toronto.

Scott has published 12 peer-reviewed articles on green roof ecology and performance, and works with the City of Toronto Planning Division on a number of projects, which have included the 'Bees of Toronto' Biodiversity Series book, and the 'Guidelines for Biodiverse Green Roofs'.
